

Resolution on the Interpretation of the Code of Ethics and Animal Welfare

Members must adhere to the WAZA Code of Ethics and Animal Welfare and ensure that they do not accept animals obtained by the use of methods which are inherently cruel. An example of such a practice is the catching of dolphins by the use of a method known as “drive fishing”.
